## **Executive Summary**

#### Introduction

At the C & I committee on 26 June a discussion ensued on future work of the committee and it was suggested that there be a focus on 'creating local wealth through tourism' particularly with reference to the Sweyne Forkebeard anniversary in 2013. It was therefore proposed that a working group be created to work with appropriate officers and Cllrs Patterson, Howitt-Cowan, Leaning and Parrott.

This action was allocated to Marion Thomas who arranged a meeting with the above Cllrs to discuss how this group should proceed.

The group agreed that it needed to find out what was happening with West Lindsey Communities ref Heritage and that a conference be organised to 'Celebrate West Lindsey's Heritage'.

## **Budget estimate**

Final figure dependent upon the number of delegates; but we are budgeting for £450

#### **Actions included:**

RAF Scampton to host the event to include a tour of the museum and lunch – booked for Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> March 2013

Prior to the event it is planned to find out what the different groups have planned for 2013 and this will be displayed around the conference room for all to see – further information will be gathered during the event including feedback from the groups as to whether they felt the meeting helped them and if they wish to repeat (annually?) and ideas on what could be done to increase visitor numbers.

The information gathered will be collated and a meeting arranged with the Tourism Working Group to discuss the way forward and next steps.

This will include identifying any gaps in events being organised and what can be done to address these – including looking at appropriate funding to enable further events to be organised.

A report will be presented to the C & I Committee with findings and potential actions by end April.

A large number of events take place in May & June, not just in West Lindsey but Lincolnshire as a whole, so it is suggested that we look at summer/autumn for any identified activity to take place.
