# **RECOMMENDATION(S):**

- 1) That Members note that the estimated surplus of £552,000 be declared as accruing in the Council's Collection Fund at 31 March 2012 relating to Council Tax transactions, and
- 2) That the Council uses its element of the Council Tax surplus in calculating the level of Council Tax in 2012/13.

#### IMPLICATIONS

**Legal:** It is a requirement under the Local Government Finance Act 1992 that any estimated surplus on the previous year's Collection Fund shall be shared amongst the major precepting bodies.

**Financial :** The sum of £552,000 estimated surplus in respect of Council Tax is shared as follows:-

Lincolnshire County Council £396,497

Lincolnshire Police Authority £66,702

West Lindsey District Council £ 88,801

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## **Collection Fund Surplus for 2012/13**

## 1 Introduction

- 1.1 The Council is required to declare an estimate of the surplus or deficit that will occur on the Collection Fund at the end of each year. The Collection Fund records the amount of income collected from Council Tax, together with precept payments to principal authorities. This amount is then taken into account when the Council Tax is determined for the following year.
- 1.2 Any surplus or deficit relating to the Council Tax is shared between the County Council, the Lincolnshire Police Authority and this Council in the same proportion as the amount of their precepts for 2011/12.
- 1.3 A surplus or deficit may occur in the Collection Fund if the Council tax base is larger or smaller than originally anticipated or collection rates are higher or lower than expected.

#### 2 Estimated Surplus for 2012/13

- 2.1 The amount calculated as available from the Collection Fund for distribution during 2012/13 has been calculated at £552,000.
- 2.2 This amount will be shared amongst the precepting authorities as follows:

2.3 This Council must take the £ 88,801 into account when it sets its element of the Council Tax for 2012/13.
