1 Introduction

- 1.1 Full Council at its meeting on 2 July 2012 **RESOLVED** that a Standards Sub-Committee comprising elected Members of the District Council, appointed proportionally, be established.
- 1.2 The Standards Sub-Committee is deemed an ordinary committee of the Council and therefore political balance requirements should apply.
- 1.3 However, following consultation with the Group Leaders, and in light of the nature of the work which will be undertaken by Standards Sub-Committee it is proposed that the political balance rules be suspended in respect of appointments thereto.
- 1.4 It is therefore suggested that the Sub-Committee's makeup should comprise a total of 6 Elected Members on the following basis: -

Conservative Group 2 x seats Liberal Democrat Group 2x seats Labour Group 1 x seat Independent 1 x seat.

- 1.5 The Sub-Committee will also comprise 3 Non Voting Parish Council Representatives, as previously resolved by Council on 2 July, and these appointments will be made by the Sub-Committee itself, in due course.
- 1.6 All Group Leaders agree with the proposals detailed at paragraph 1.3 and the number of members detailed at paragraph 1.4 above.
