1 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

4 GAMBLING ACT - STATEMENT OF PRINCIPLES

The policy was intended to guide decision makers, applicants, objectors and others regarding the decision making process.

The Committee gave consideration to the statement of principles with a view to recommending it to Full Council for adoption. Members commented that there were no changes to the policy, and after being proposed and seconded it was

RESOLVED that the Gambling Act 2005 – Statement of Principles be approved for **RECOMMENDATION** to Full Council, at its next meeting (4 November 2024) for final determination.
