## 1 Background

- 1.1 Under the Representation of the Peoples Act 1983 each Council in England are required to appoint an officer to be the Electoral Registration Officer and Returning Officer.
- 1.2 These roles are currently assigned to Alan Robinson, Director of Resources and have been since 2017.
- 1.3 Council will be aware that Mr Robinson is due to depart the authority on 31 March, to take up a position with South Kesteven District Council.
- 1.4 Due to the departure of the current post holder, it is essential that a new appointment is made.

## 2. Summary of Statutory Duties

- 2.1 Statutory duties of the Electoral Registration Officer are:
  - Maintain a register of Parliamentary electors
  - Maintain a register of local government electors
  - Conduct an annual canvass
  - (Expenses in performance of these functions shall be paid by the council)
  - If ERO found guilty of any act or omission in breach of their official duties they shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine.
- 2.2 Statutory duties of the Returning Officer are:
  - Be impartial and ensure that the conduct of an election is in accordance with the law.
  - Report any discrepancy or alleged unlawful act to the police.
  - Responsibility is of a personal nature and is distinct from his/her duties as an employee of the Council.
  - If RO found guilty of any act or omission in breach of their official duties they shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine.

### 3. Recommendation

It is recommended that

- (a) In accordance with the requirements of Sections 8 and 35 of the Representation of the Peoples Act 1983, Mr Ian Knowles, Chief Executive, be appointed as the Council's Electoral Registration Officer and Returning Officer with immediate effect.
- (b) The Constitution be amended, as necessary, to reflect this revised appointment.
