

2 Horsemarket Caistor - Today's Local

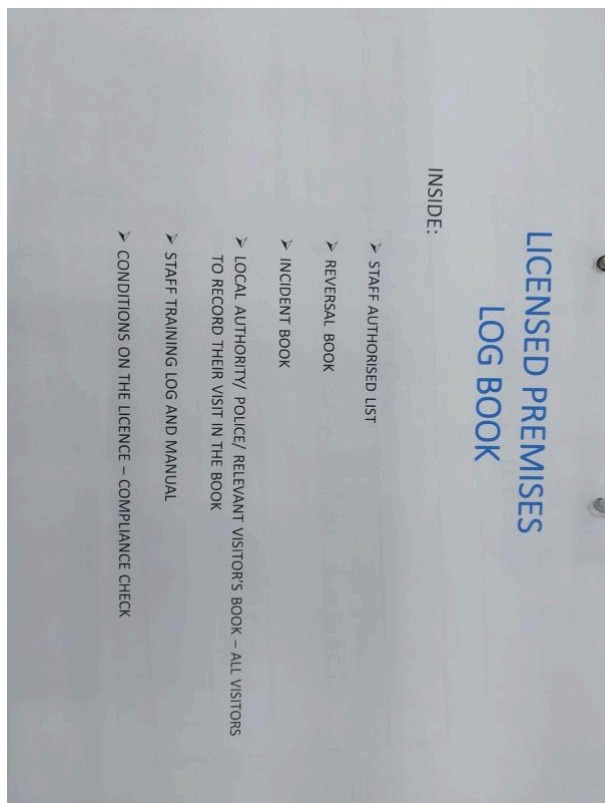
